The California Public Utilities Commission Deaf and Disabled Telecommunications Program

offers eligible Californians FREE specialized telephones and equipment. If you have trouble seeing, hearing, moving, speaking, or remembering, and this makes it difficult to use a standard telephone, you may benefit from one of our specialized phones. No landline? No problem! Cellphone Amplifiers can make your cellphone louder.

There are no hidden fees and no income requirements.

Applying for this State program is easy. Just call to request an application or download from their website below. Fill out the application form, have your medical professional sign, and then just mail, email, or fax the form back to us. If you have questions, call the Contact Center at 1-800-806-1191. - A vision program for people age 55 and older who are Blind (OIB);
- Assistance with applications for CalFresh and other supplementary programs;
- A Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS)
 program offering portable batteries or help
 making reservations at local hotels during
 power shutdowns, and with Medical Baseline
 screening and applications to help save on
 utility bills;
- Independent Living Skills classes to help with budgeting, menu planning, organization, emergency planning, and socialization;
- Voice Options, a program to help those who have lost their communication skills due to stroke, cancer, or any other factor that uses Assistive Technology for communication at a professional level, such as Doctor appointments, or social engagements.
