



# **CORNING OFFICE TO CLOSE SHORT-TERM**

**CORNING** » The Social Services office in Corning will be temporarily closing Dec. 21 after a vote Tuesday by the Tehama County Board of Supervisors.

Tehama County Social Services Director Laura Hawkins said her department is struggling with staffing shortages.

"So one of the mandates that we have is to make sure that customers get their benefits in a timely fashion," Hawkins said. "In order to do that, our operations staff that would run the front desk also do the back-office work. So if you imagine it, like a medical office, the front door, and also the back-office work, and we simply do not have people. We simply do within the next week, you have to get not." The Corning office is down to 12 from 23 eligibility specialists, and all the office assistants have been brought up to Red Bluff to run that site.

There has been difficulty recruiting employees, but Tehama County is not alone with this issue. Hawkins said she talked to her counterpart in Glenn County, who said that agency is likewise facing problems hiring people.

"In order to keep the ability to serve the entire county, the only mandate we have by the state is to have one office," Hawkins said. "We would like to keep this (office) to go back here as soon as we out from working as long as they are get staffed up. But

as of right now, we do not have the capacity to keep a lobby and, or the site open."

Supervisor Bill Moule asked whether it was feasible for the office to open up one day a week.

Hawkins said the Red Bluff office would have to sacrifice too much of its staff to do what Moule suggested.

Supervisor Candy Carlson favored allowing Hawkins to close the office but gave a caveat that a solution needs to be found, and there needed to be a limit on how long the office would be closed.

"If this has come to this point, where it's at a crisis level, and there is not a way to resolve it in the immediate future, like people trained to work a desk or to do something," Carlson said. "You have people."

Supervisor Bob Williams suggested a monthlong temporary closure and Hawkins said that was acceptable.

"We absolutely know that the public is important," Hawkins said. "There is no part of that, and I feel like there is divisiveness trying to make it look like we do not care, and it is absolutely not true. The fact of the matter is we also have people here. They are also part of our public employees, and they are burnt working."

The supervisors voted 4-1 for the closure. Supervisor John Leach was the dissenting vote. Leach said he voted no because the office is in his district.

Hawkins will come back

to the supervisors on Jan. 25, 2022 to discuss reopening the office.

The Red Bluff Social Services office is at 310 Main St. It is open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays and can be reached at 527-1911.

# ORAL HEALTH MEANS MORE THAN HEALTHY TEETH!

You may have heard the saying that what happens in Vegas, stays in Vegas. But what happens in the mouth doesn't stay in the mouth!

The mouth is the gateway to the rest of the body. An unhealthy mouth can increase risk for even greater disease. These complications can include increased risk of stroke, heart attack, diabetes, some types of cancer, and arthritis.

The mouth is home to hundreds of different types of bacteria. Although some of them are linked to increased health risks, many of them are good and play a key part in a healthy mouth. There are 20 billion bacteria in your mouth and they reproduce every 5 hours. That means if you go 24 hours without brushing, those 20 billion become 100 billion! Your mouth is a kind of ecosystem, an oral microbiome that is intrinsically linked with gut health because 45% of the bacteria in the mouth are also found in the gut. Every time you swallow, you are seeding your gastrointestinal tract with bacteria (good or bad), fungi, and even viruses from your mouth, up to 140 billion per day. A healthy mouth is essential for a healthy gut and a healthy gut is vital for the overall health of the body.

Some common signs of problems that you should be aware of include:

- bleeding when brushing or flossing
- · red swollen gums
- · bad breath
- · loose teeth

# A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

# CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT

PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY, RE-RATIFYING THE PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY BY GOVERNOR'S ORDER DATED MARCH 4, 2020 AND AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF CORNINGHEALTHCARE DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD OF DECEMBER 21, 2021 TO JANUARY 20, 2022 PURSUANT TO BROWN ACT PROVISIONS.

WHEREAS, the CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT is committed to preserving and nurturing public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of the CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT's legislative body is open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code 54950 - 54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch the District's legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by conditions as described in Government Code section 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the jurisdictions that are within the District's boundaries, caused by natural, technological, or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, it is further required that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, or, the legislative body meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors previously adopted a Resolution, Number 10-6-21 on October 6, 2021 finding that the requisite conditions exist for the legislative body of CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT to conduct remote teleconference meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953. This Resolution was re-ratified on November 16, 2021 based on a further finding that the requisite conditions continued to exist for the legislative body of CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT to conduct remote teleconference meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953.; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of extending the use of the provisions found in section 54953(e), the Board of Directors must reconsider the circumstances of the state of emergency that exists in the District, and the Board of Directors has done so; and

WHEREAS, such conditions now exist in the District, specifically, the State of Emergency declared by Governor Newsom on March 4, 2020, due to COVID-19. Pursuant to the Governor's subsequent Executive Order N-29-20, issued on March 17, 2020 a local legislative body is authorized to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to attend and to address the local legislative body. Masks are now optional for fully vaccinated employees and members of the public. Based on Occupational Safety & Hazard Agency (OSHA) standards, those entering without a mask are self-attesting to being fully vaccinated; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the rise in SARS-CoV-2 Delta Variant has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the District that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the District, and desires to proclaim a local emergency exists and ratify the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the District shall continue to conduct meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, and that such legislative bodies shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953; and;

WHEREAS, the CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT commenced virtual meeting protocols on April 21, 2020 which include options for public participation.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the CORNING HEALTHCARE DISTRICT as follows:

- 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.
- 2. <u>Proclamation of Local Emergency</u>. The Board hereby proclaims that a local emergency now exists throughout the District, and COVID-19 has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the District that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the District.
- 3. <u>Ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency</u>. The Board hereby ratifies the Governor of the State of California's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of March 4, 2020.
- 4. <u>Remote Teleconference Meetings</u>. The District Manager and Staff of the District are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including, but not limited to, conducting open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.
- 5. Effective Date of Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect on December 21, 2021, and shall be effective until the earlier of January 20, 2022, or such time the Board of Directors adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to extend the time during which the legislative bodies of the District may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953.
