

# The Need

St. Elizabeth's primary fundraising focus is on the purchase of a new ambulance for Tehama County along with updating aging equipment to stock the rig. Additionally, our goal is to install a power loader in the new ambulance to assist in lifting gurneys and patients in the rig. This will help curtail back injuries which are the #1 injury experienced by EMS personnel.

Cardiac Monitor: \$42,000

**Power Gurney*:** \$32,000

Power Loader: \$32,000

Some facts about mushrooms

Mushrooms are prized for their flavor,
nutritional value, and medicinal properties.

Most mushrooms fall into one of four categories: Saprotrophs – decomposers that thrive on decay (e.g. Reishi, Shiitake, White Button, Cremini); Mycorrhizal mushrooms that partner with plants for their mutual benefit (e.g. Porcini, Chanterelles); Parasitic mushrooms that grow on a plant host and eventually kill it (Lion's Mane, Chaga); and Endophytes, a unique type of mushroom somewhere between the other three. Endophytes have a mysterious relationship with plants that is not yet fully understood.

Matsutake Mushrooms from Japan are an Autumn delicacy and may be the rarest and most expensive of the over 10,000 kinds of edible mushrooms. The price of this Mycorrhizal continues to rise due to disappearing habitat.

# SEPTEMBER IS EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS MONTH

Emergencies and disasters can be natural or man-made. Examples of disasters include (but are not limited to) fire, flood, landslide, tornado, thunderstorm, power outages, volcano, heat wave, Hazardous Materials (HazMat) spills, terrorism (including active shooter), highway or railroad safety, food poisoning, disease and pandemics. Depending on the type of emergency, you may be advised to evacuate or to shelter in place. Be ready by keeping a Go Bag for evacuations and a Stay Box for sheltering in place. Remember to include: Water - one gallon per person, per day • Food, non-perishable, easy-to-prepare • Flashlight • Battery-powered or hand-crank radio (NOAA Weather Radio, if possible) • Extra batteries • First-aid kit • Medications (7day supply) and medical items • Multi-purpose tool & can opener • Sanitation & personal hygiene items • Copies of personal documents • Cell phone with chargers • Family & emergency contact information • Extra cash.

Don't forget the needs of your pets!

### THUNDERSTORM SAFETY

- If you can hear thunder, you are close enough to be in danger from lightning. The National Weather Service recommends:
- Stay inside for at least 30 minutes after the last thunder clap.
- Avoid electrical equipment and telephones.
- Use battery-powered TVs and radios instead.
- Shutter windows and close outside doors securely.
- Keep away from windows. Do not take a bath, shower or use plumbing.
- If you are driving, try to safely exit the roadway and park. Stay in the vehicle and turn on the emergency flashers until the heavy rain ends. Avoid touching metal or other surfaces that conduct electricity in and outside the vehicle.

If you are outside and cannot reach a safe building, avoid high ground; water; tall, isolated trees; and metal objects such as fences or bleachers. Picnic shelters, dugouts and sheds are NOT safe.

# - APPROVAL OF A GRANT FOR GOVERNANCE TRAINING FOR THE CORNING SENIOR CENTER

Below is information regarding a weeklong training program offered by North Valley Community Foundation for nonprofit leaders. This training would be valuable to board members or staff from the Corning Senior Center. It includes fundraising techniques and grant opportunities for non-profit organizations.

Key staff, volunteers and board members of nonprofit organizations can apply now to attend the second annual Nonprofit Institute, a weeklong intensive training program for nonprofit leaders.

The Nonprofit Institute is guided by the North Valley Community Foundation's leadership program, Lead, according to a press release issued Wednesday by the North Valley Community Foundation.

The week's objective is to help build the health of nonprofits in the north valley. The week will be filled with seasoned coaches and facilitators focused on topics of unique significance to the broad range of nonprofits in the region.

Topics include board and staff relations, governance, management and revenue generation while building skills and practices around leadership, personal strengths, team building and collaboration.

The institute will be held entirely in Grass Valley to help participants focus in an off-site environment, the release said. There will be a mandatory introductory meeting on Dec. 8 in Chico. The weeklong training runs Jan. 8-12, 2024, with meetings and overnight lodging at the Gold Miners' Inn.

Participants will stay overnight from Jan. 8-11. The deadline to apply is Sept. 30. Double-occupancy rooms, materials and food are included in the \$2,000 cost. Scholarships are available.
