# **Corning Healthcare District Report**

### **NUMBERS SERVED**

The Corning Healthcare District Elder Services Program has provided service to 106 clients from July through September. This number reflects in-person talks and presentations, referrals, and other kinds of informal help.

### **HEALTH TALKS**

Elaine continues to offer presentations during the congregate lunches at the Corning Senior Center where she shares health and safety information pertinent to seniors. Topics for this quarter were as follows:

- July Summer heat safety
- August Nutrition for Older Adults
- September Emergency Preparedness

In **July** Elaine offered two talks, one at the Corning Senior Center and one at Tehama Village, about staying safe in the summer heat. Since we were in the midst of a heatwave, the topic was most timely. She talked about the importance of hydration, ways to stay hydrated, the role of electrolytes, the symptoms of heat stress, signs of heat stroke, how to avoid it and what to do if it happens. Elaine gave everyone a cooling towel. The raffle prize at both sites was an iced beverage jar with a large box if Lipton iced tea bags. See photos below.

In August Elaine chose to talk about the special nutritional needs of older adults. There are a number of factors that contribute to malnutrition in older adults, including: poverty; lack of access to healthy food (either because of distance or mobility problems); low energy levels and lack of convenience (it doesn't take much energy and it's more convenient to throw something pre-prepared into the microwave, but most of those things are highly processed, high in fat, high in sodium, high in useless calories but low in fiber and nutritional value); chronic illness; medications (which can reduce appetite, create cravings for unhealthy food, or change the way food tastes; isolation (eating is a social behavior and eating alone can be discouraging); loss of smell (we lose some of our sense of taste and smell as we age – how we taste food to a large degree depends upon our sense of smell, the bottom line being that if food does not taste good, we don't want to eat it); and finally, poor oral health (missing teeth or ill-fitting dentures can make chewing difficult). Elaine noted that as we age, our nutritional

needs change, we lose muscle mass, bone mass, and have need of fewer calories, so we need to choose our food wisely and make our calories count. Food can help us or hurt us so she encouraged her listeners to "Eat a Rainbow" by selecting fruits and vegetables in a variety of colors. She also briefly discussed probiotics/prebiotics and gut health, so-called "Superfoods" and foods that reduce inflammation. Elaine gave away two insulated lunch boxes. No photos (Elaine was too busy talking).

September was Emergency & Disaster Preparedness Month and October is Fire Safety Month, so in addition to her monthly Health Talk at the Corning Senior Center, Elaine combined the two topics and gave presentations at Tehama Village in Corning, Sherwood Manor in Los Molinos, and by special request, at Villa Columba in Red Bluff (the September Health Talk at the Corning Senior Center focused exclusively on Emergency Preparedness because Fire Safety will be discussed in October and will include a visit from the Corning Fire Chief). At Sherwood Manor, Elaine invited firefighters from the local Fire Department to talk about fire safety. She followed up with a discussion about the different kinds of emergencies that could occur (everything from Active Shooter to Volcanic Eruptions) and how to be prepared (Evacuation vs. Shelter in Place). She offered similar talks in Corning and Red Bluff without the presence of firefighters. Two raffle prizes - an Emergency Preparedness Go Bag and a Home Fire Extinguisher were given away at each of the three combined workshops and two Emergency Go Bags (one for a woman and one for a man) were raffled off at the Corning Senior Center (where the Home Fire Extinguisher will be October's raffle prize following the Fire Chief's demonstration). ### **FILE OF LIFE**

File of Life was included in the Emergency Go Bags and offered at all of the Emergency Preparedness workshops Elaine did during this quarter.

### **COMMUNITY OUTREACH**

Elaine continues to represent the Corning Healthcare District at events and meetings that affect seniors including (but not limited to) the Elder Services Coordinating Council, the Diversability Advocacy Network: the California Food Alliance; and the Commission on Aging.

### **OTHER**

- **Newsletter** the **Autumn edition** of the CHD Elder Services Newsletter was sent out in early September.
- Facebook Elaine maintained the CHD Facebook page.
- A Facebook page, Corning Ca. Crime Watch & Community info, was created by the manager of Tehama Village following Elaine's suggestion. The purpose of the page is to help residents stay safe by connecting and communicating with one another.

Elaine has responded to requests for help by providing information and educational material on a variety of health-related topics. During the months included in this report, Elaine took inquires and requests from seniors needing help or information on a variety of topics, including: Caregiving, Telephones and Assisted Hearing Devices, Housing, Medicare.

### **SUMMARY**

During the months included in this report, Elder Services provided health and safety information and community outreach to seniors in Tehama County. In addition, networking was achieved, vital contacts made, and the public profile of the Corning Healthcare District was enhanced.
